ICRA Business Meeting -

The ICRA Business Meeting was called to order at 8:15am by ICRA President Kathy Jurries. Kathy led the group in the Pledge of Allegiance.

Next Kathy asked if everyone reviewed the Meeting Minutes from the August 27th Meeting and the Treasurer's Report. There was a motion made by Deb Winke, Allamakee County Recorder to approve the Minutes and the Amended Treasurer's Report and it was seconded by Sue Meyer, Clayton County Recorder. The Amendment made to the Treasurer's report by ICRA Treasurer Lisa Kent was to transfer \$1500 out of Hospitality to the General fund to cover the expense of MJ Productions, the entertainment for the vendor event. John Murphy, Dubuque County Recorder presented a plaque to Travis Case for 2 years of service as the ICRA President (2019-2020) and apologized for the delay of presentation due to Covid. Also a plaque was presented by John to Kathy Jurries for 1 years as ICRA President (2021).
